

16A Midterm 1 Statistics (001)

Here are the basic statistics from the first midterm. The table shows the scores at each percentile boundary. For example the 70th percentile is 102/125. This means that 30% of the class received 102 or above. The 50th percentile is where the median is, so exactly half the class scored 87 or above. Also indicated are the rough grade boundaries if your grade was to be decided on this test alone.

Remember your final letter grade is only determined once all your scores have been compiled so don't take these predictions too seriously. As indicated in the course policy if you're relative score in the final (i.e the percentile) is higher than your relative score in the lowest midterm it will replace it in your final grade computation.
